- ▶ All juniors are required to complete a first meeting by **April 12**. (There are only 10 school days until the first meeting deadline once we return from break.) Counselor schedules for the week we return from break (March 30-April 2) will not be posted until *Tuesday, March 30* (the day we return from break).

For your first meeting...

- You will need to turn in your **completed Student Response Form (SRF) with essay at least a day before your meeting.**
 - The SRF is in the materials you received at the kick-off program. If you prefer to use a computerized version, the SRF is posted to MiltOnline under "Conferences – College Office – Class II" and it can also be downloaded from www.milton.edu under "Academics – College Counseling – Class II information." (The **Parent Response Form (PRF)**, which was also included in the materials handed out at the kick-off program, can be found electronically in the same locations should your parents prefer a computerized version.)
 - **Your advisor should attend your first scheduled meeting.** (Please provide your advisor with a copy of your SRF prior to the meeting.) It is your responsibility to find out your advisor's free periods and schedule a meeting accordingly.
- ▶ The deadline for completing your second college meeting is **April 26**. Remember, **you must meet with two different counselors for your first two meetings.** If your advisor could not attend the first meeting, he or she should plan to come to your second college meeting.
 - ▶ Access the College Counseling Handbook by logging in to your myMilton (where you access attendance and course registration) and following the link to the handbook. We expect you to be familiar with all material in the handbook; it answers many of the questions you might have.
 - ▶ The registration deadline for the **May 1** SAT and Subject Tests is **March 31**. You should register at www.collegeboard.com. Students are responsible for their own SAT registration. (Milton Academy is a test site for the May 1 SAT and Subject Tests.)
 - ▶ For those who plan to take the **April 10** ACT, the registration deadline is **March 5**. You should register at www.actstudent.org. Students are responsible for their own ACT registration. (Milton Academy is a test site for the April 10 ACT.)
