- ▶ If you have not completed the second of your *two required meetings* please sign up **ASAP**. New schedules are posted every Thursday morning. You must meet with two different college counselors for your first two meetings. If your advisor was unable to attend your first meeting, he/she should attend the second meeting. Bring your completed yellow sheet to the second meeting.
- ▶ The registration deadline for the **June 5** SAT Reasoning and Subject Tests is **tomorrow, May 5**. (Milton Academy is a test site for the June 5 SAT and Subject Tests.) You should register at www.collegeboard.com. Students are responsible for their own SAT registration.
- ▶ For those who plan to take the **June 12** ACT, the registration deadline is this **Friday, May 7**. You should register at www.actstudent.org. Students are responsible for their own ACT registration. (Milton Academy is not a test site for the June 12 ACT.)
- ▶ Access the College Counseling Handbook by logging in to your myMilton (where you access attendance and course registration) and following the link to the handbook. We expect you to be familiar with all material in the handbook; it answers many of the questions you might have.
