- ▶ We will have a **required meeting** with those of you who are applying to any of the **University of California** schools on **Tuesday, October 18** at 3:00 p.m. in Straus. Please RSVP to Mrs. Dunnington by **Friday, October 14** so that we can have your transcript prepared before that meeting.
- ▶ As we look ahead to the November 1 early application deadline, the College Office will be very busy. If you would like one of the counselors to review your essay, please put a printed copy (with your name on it) in the folder on Mrs. Dunnington's desk by **October 21**. Counselors will get the draft(s) back to you as soon as they can.
- ▶ The counselors will be taking meetings with parents of boarding students this Friday during Parents' Weekend. If you would like to schedule a meeting for your parent(s), please see Mrs. Dunnington.
- ▶ The late registration deadline for the November 5 SAT is **October 21**.
  - Please look at [www.collegeboard.com/student](http://www.collegeboard.com/student) to note when various SAT Subject Tests are offered. **Not all SAT Subject Tests are offered on every test date!**
  - In the past, colleges have received scores from the November test date in time for consideration of early applications. **DO NOT RUSH YOUR SCORES unless the college specifically asks you to do so.**
- ▶ The registration deadline for the December 10 ACT is November 4.
- ▶ If you are applying to an early decision/early action/rolling school, the **Secondary School Report Form** and the **Online Recommendation Release Form** were due to Mrs. Dunnington **October 7**. If you have not completed these forms, please submit them **ASAP**. (Forms are available in Mrs. Dunnington's office.) Besides these forms, the following steps are necessary:
  - Send your test scores officially from the College Board or ACT to the college(s). The College Office will not send any scores to colleges and scores do NOT appear on your transcript. (You can send scores officially through [www.collegeboard.com/student](http://www.collegeboard.com/student) or [www.actstudent.org](http://www.actstudent.org).)
  - If you are applying to a non-Common App school, give Teacher Recommendation forms to teachers with stamped, addressed envelopes. Envelopes should be standard size, preferably pull-and-stick closure, with the return address of teacher name, c/o Milton Academy, 170 Centre Street, Milton, MA 02186. (You do not need to provide teachers with forms or envelopes for schools that use the Common Application.)
- ▶ Those who are not applying early should be working on their college lists and essays, visiting with us, and thinking about asking for teacher recommendations. (For more details on teacher recommendations, please refer to the *Etiquette of the Ask* that was attached to previous newsletters.)

- ▶ You should self-report your AP scores when filling out your applications. You should not pay to have the scores sent officially through AP Services.
- ▶ If you must answer "yes" to the question about Disciplinary Action on your applications, you need to come by and talk to one of us about your response. You are expected to answer these questions honestly.
- ▶ For those of you applying for financial aid, you should file a CSS/Profile Form online at www.collegeboard.com. They began to accept forms on October 1, 2011.
- ▶ If you qualify or think you might qualify for application or test fee waivers, please check-in with Mrs. Dunnington.
- ▶ If you are applying to U. Wisconsin, U. Colorado, or any other rolling admission university, please inform us as soon as possible. In most cases, the earlier you apply to these schools, the better. ***If you apply online, there may be a Secondary School Report (SSR) form that you must download and bring to the College Office.***
- ▶ If you are an athlete who is being recruited or might be recruited by a Division I or Ivy League school, you must register with the **NCAA Clearinghouse** before you can have an official visit. Please be sure to download and submit the Transcript Request Form to Mrs. Dunnington.
