

Instructions for Accessing the College Handbook

For Students:


→ Log in to your myMilton (where you access attendance and course registration) and follow the link to the College Handbook.

For Parents:

→ Go to www.milton.edu – Parents – myMilton (the same place you access grades and comments for your student).

→ Log in to myMilton (if you don't remember your log-in information, there is a help link available there).

→ Once you are logged in, look for a notice to Class II parents on the homepage. Follow the link to the College Handbook directly under the notice. (See illustration below)
