Laundry

Each campus house is equipped with **free** washers and dryers for student use. Additionally, E&R Laundry Service will provide a laundry bag for weekly washing of each students' linens (2 sheets, 3 towels, and 1 pillowcase). *This service is included in each boarding student's tuition.* E&R laundry bags will be delivered during the opening of school or may be requested later from facilities. At an additional cost, E&R will offer dry cleaning and laundering of clothes, blankets, or comforters. E&R will provide sign-up information directly to boarding families during the summer.

Refrigerators

Each house is equipped with a kitchenette and a full-sized refrigerator for common use. Should a personal refrigerator be needed, students should coordinate with their roommate(s) to avoid unnecessary duplication. If a student purchases a personal refrigerator, it must draw less than 2.0 amps, and ideally 1.5 amps ($\text{Amps} = \text{Watts/Volts}$), be in excellent running order, and have the ability to be plugged directly into a wall socket (not into an extension cord or power strip).

Storage space is very limited, so summer storage of student refrigerators on campus requires prior approval.

The following items will **not** be allowed in the dorm

Students should not bring the following prohibited items:

- Air conditioners
- Candles
- Cloth wall hangings
- Electric blankets
- Furniture not provided by the Academy
- Halogen lamps
- Hooks, shelves, and anything that requires a screw or nail to affix to the wall
- Incense
- Irons (provided in each dormitory)
- Matches & lighters
- Microwaves (provided in each dormitory)
- Monitors, screens or displays greater than 20" diagonal
- Pets, including fish
- Printers and printer paper (provided in each dormitory)
- Projectors
- Space heaters
- Televisions
